RESOLUTION NUMBER 01-002 **RESOLUTION OF COOPERATION WITH THE KETTL** **COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION IMPLIMENTATIONS**

WHEREAS, local governments have an exemplary record of providing cost-effective and reliable service; and local government leaders are committed to continuous improvement in the efficiency and reliability of those services, and

WHEREAS, partnerships among local governments have consistently provided benefits to citizens and taxpayers in Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, local government cooperation in the areas of transportation, municipal utilities, service delivery and procurement of equipment and supplies has lowered taxes and improved the quality of life in Southeastern Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the recently completed report from the Governor's Commission on State/Local Partnerships for the 21st Century, chaired by Professor Don Kettl, calls for even greater collaboration among municipalities,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Legislative Committee of the Mid-Moraine Municipal Association continue to embrace the concept of incentives for municipalities to work together on local services that could be provided more efficiently through municipal cooperation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Legislative Committee of the Mid-Moraine Municipal Association** endorses and supports the Southeastern Municipal Executives' offer to authorize a committee of its members to recommend specific areas of improved governmental cooperation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Legislative Committee of the Mid-Moraine Municipal Association** supports and joins the Southeastern Municipal Executives' offer of full participation in the debate over the future of intergovernmental cooperation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to all members of the association, their elected Representatives and Senators, the Speaker of the Wisconsin State Assembly, the State Senate Majority Leader and the Governor of the State of Wisconsin.
